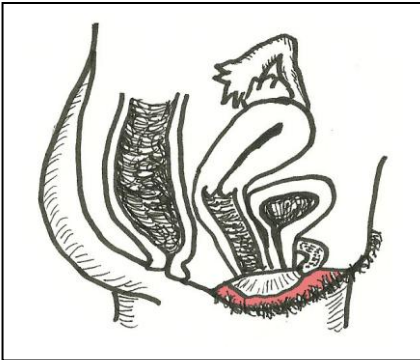


THE MONS VENERIS

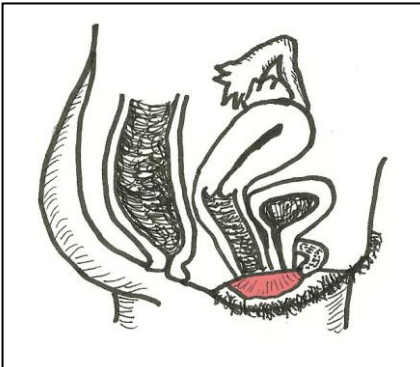
A cut through the midline of the pelvis would also cut through the middle of the mons veneris.



THE LABIA MAJORA

A cut through the midline of the pelvis would run in between the labia majora, which would remain intact, one complete labium being present on each half of the body.

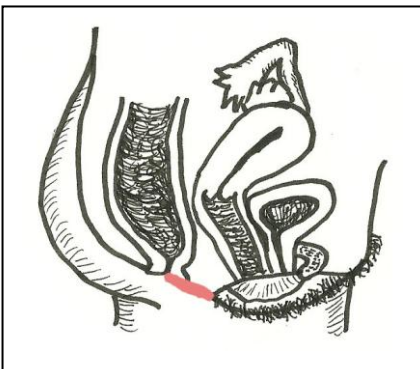
Note that the labia majora are bigger than the labia minora, further from the midline (therefore behind the labia minora in this view), and covered with hair (which the labia minora lack).



THE LABIA MINORA

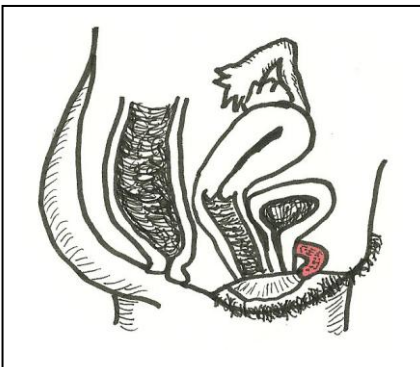
A cut through the midline of the pelvis would run in between the labia minora, which would remain intact, one complete labium being present on each half of the body

Note that the labia minora are smaller than the labia majora, closer to the midline (therefore in front of the labia majora in this view), and lacking hair (which the labia majora are covered with).



THE PERINEUM

A cut through the midline of the pelvis would also cut through the middle of the perineum which is located between the vaginal opening and the rectal opening.



THE CLITORIS

A cut through the midline of the pelvis would also cut through the midline of the clitoris (head or glans, and shaft)
