



	<p><b>THE TESTICLE (THE TESTIS)</b></p> <p>The place where sperm are produced.  The place where testosterone is produced.  (Though some testosterone is also made in the adrenal glands)</p>
	<p><b>THE EPIDIDYMIS</b></p> <p>The place where sperm are temporarily stored and undergo maturation.</p>
	<p><b>THE VAS DEFERENS</b></p> <p>The tube that carries sperm from testicle to urethra.   The structure that is cut in a vasectomy.</p>
	<p><b>THE SEMINAL VESICLES</b></p> <p>The structures that make 70% of the volume of the ejaculate.</p>
	<p><b>THE BULBOURETHRAL GLAND (THE COWPER'S GLAND)</b></p> <p>The structure that produces a droplet of fluid before ejaculation (the pre-cum).</p> <p>Because sperm from previous ejaculations may swim into this gland, pre-cum may contain small numbers of sperm, one reason why withdrawal is not a very effective method of birth control.</p>
